Geek Expo is dedicated to providing a safe, welcoming, and inclusive environment for all attendees, guests, staff, volunteers, and performers. By attending Geek Expo, you agree to abide by this Code of Conduct.

1. Expected Behavior

All participants are expected to:

- Treat everyone with respect, kindness, and courtesy.
- Respect personal space and physical boundaries.
- Use appropriate language and behavior; harassment, discrimination, or intimidation will not be tolerated.
- Follow event rules, venue guidelines, and staff instructions.
- Respect the privacy of others, including not taking photos or videos without permission.

2. Unacceptable Behavior

Unacceptable behaviors include, but are not limited to:

- Harassment, intimidation, or discriminatory comments or actions based on race, ethnicity, gender identity, sexual orientation, disability, religion, age, or any other protected characteristic.
- Physical or verbal threats or abuse.
- Stalking or unwanted attention.
- Disruption of panels, workshops, performances, or other activities.
- Theft or damage to property.
- Sharing personal information of others without consent.

3. Cosplay Guidelines

- Costumes must be safe and non-threatening; realistic weapons are not allowed unless approved by event staff.
- Nudity or revealing attire is prohibited.
- Props must be carried responsibly and not obstruct pathways or pose a danger to others.

4. Reporting Issues

5. Consequences

Violation of this Code of Conduct may result in:

- Warning or removal from specific activities.
- Removal from the event without refund.
- Notification to law enforcement if necessary.
- Banning from future Geek Expo events.
